









IMPORTANT: Turn the Chuck Throw Off anti-clockwise (towards you) so it is back at it's original position.










Sani Grinder - How to apply/remove Polishing Buff


PRIOR TO APPLYING/REMOVING DRUM, ENSURE TO SWITCH THE MAINS POWER OFF.

PLEASE NOTE: The Tapered Chuck and Polishing Buff are not supplied with the purchase of a SaniGrinder.


1. Turn the Chuck Throw Off clockwise (away from you) until the drum is loose or pushed from the tapered shaft.

4. Push the Tapered Chuck firmly onto the Tapered Shaft. Give a good tap to the end of the Chuck to ensure a secure fit. The Tapered Shaft will hold the Chuck in place.





5. Take the Polishing Buff and screw it clockwise onto the Tapered Chuck (ensuring to screw on via the end with the plastic disc).
