## Water Distiller User Manual




# **IMPORTANT:**

PLEASE READ THIS INSTRUCTION MANUAL BEFORE OPERATING THE WATER DISTILLER FOR THE FIRST TIME. FAILURE TO DO SO MAY RESULT IN MACHINE MALFUNCTION, REDUCE THE LIFE-SPAN OF THE MACHINE AND/OR VOID WARRANTY. TO PROLONG THE WORKING LIFE OF THIS UNIT, WE SUGGEST THAT AN EXTERNAL TIMING DEVICE (NOT INCLUDED) BE USED TO AVOID THIS DEVICE BOILING DRY DURING OPERATION.

#### **BEFORE USE:**

Unpack the Water Distiller and check all the components are present and undamaged. The box should contain:

- A. 1 x Water Distiller
- **B.** 1 x Water Storage Cannister
- C. 1 x Discharge Cap
- D. 1 x Cannister Cap
- E. 1 x Filter
- F. 1 x Mains Power Cord
- G. 1 x Jar of Chamber Cleaning Crystals



#### **INITIAL SET-UP:**

- 1. Remove Water Cannister from the inside of the Water Distiller.
- 2. Fill the Water Distiller Chamber with water to the highest point indicated (marked `FULL' on the inside of chamber). You can reduce the time needed to distill water by pre-boiling the water to be distilled.
- 3. Place the Top Cover onto the machine's body whilst making sure the silicone seal is correctly in place around the entire rim. Ensure the unit is situated on a stable surface then connect the power cord from the Top Cover to the Main Unit Body.
- 4. Place the Discharge Cap on the Storage Cannister. Place the Cannister under the Filter. Connect the Mains Power Cord to power outlet.
- 5. Press the "Start Button". The fan will switch on automatically and the tank will begin to heat, thus starting the distilling process.
- 6. Distilled water will begin to drip into the Storage Cannister after approximately 30 minutes. It will take approximately 4 hours to distill 4 litres of water. The unit will automatically shut down when the cycle has finished.

#### PLEASE NOTE:

The unit must be allowed to cool down before starting another distilling cycle (this will help prevent injuries from scalding water and prolong the life-span of the Water Distiller). DO NOT USE THE FIRST CANNISTER OF DISTILLED WATER PRODUCED BY THE MACHINE. IT TAKES ONE FULL DISTILLING CYCLE FOR THE UNIT TO 'SELF-CLEAN'. ONCE THE UNIT HAS COOLED, RINSE AND WIPE OUT THE TANK. DISCARD WATER PRODUCED FROM FIRST CYCLE.

#### **IMPORTANT NOTES:**

- Disconnect Mains Power Cord when unit is not in use. When Mains Power Cord is plugged in, always ensure there is water in the chamber.
- Use the unit in a dry, well ventilated area.
- Keep the body of the unit dry only fill with water using a jug.
- "Start Button" will begin distilling cycle and the unit will automatically turn itself off once cycle has finished. To stop the unit mid-cycle, remove Mains Power Cord from socket.
- Do not immerse any part of the unit in water.
- Do not remove the Top Cover whilst unit is mid-cycle. Wait until unit has cooled down before removing top.

#### CLEANING:

Rinse and wipe-out the tank chamber everyday using clean water. Calcification and scale will build up on the bottom of the tank and should be removed approxiamtely every 2 weeks (depending on frequency of use). To clean the tank, follow the instructions below:

- 1. Pour enough hot water to cover scale in the tank.
- 2. Place 1-4 teaspoons of Cleaning Crystals into the tank depending on the amount of scale.
- 3. Leave the lid of the unit open and start up a cycle by pressing the "Start Button".
- 4. Let cycle run for 30 minutes, pour out water and wash the inside of the tank with clean water.
- 5. If scale is not completely removed repeat the process.

#### FILTER REPLACEMENT:

The Water Distiller Filter should be replaced approximately every 2-3 months. To replace the filter, follow the instructions below:

- 1. Remove Top Cover and place upside-down.
- 2. Squeeze filter in towards Top Cover to release from water outlet.
- 3. Remove Filter from water outlet.
- 4. Check that new Filter is free of visible contaminants.
- 5. Insert new Filter using reverse of the above instructions.
